It is hereby ORDERED that:


1. Lead counsel for all parties shall appear for an initial pretrial conference ("IPTC") on **December 12, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.**
2. At least **four business days prior to the IPTC**, the parties shall jointly submit a proposed schedule in accordance with the Court's Patent Case Management Plan and Scheduling Order form, available at <http://www.nysd.uscourts.gov/judge/Forrest>.
3. Counsel shall consult the Court's Individual Practices in Civil Cases, available at <http://www.nysd.uscourts.gov/judge/Forrest>, and comply with all other requirements for the IPTC. See Rule 4.B.
4. Counsel shall also consult Judge Forrest's Procedures for Patent Cases, available as Attachment B to the Court's Individual Practices in Civil Cases (as revised on November 22, 2013), and comply with all

requirements therein. In particular, the Court directs counsel's attention to Rule 1.a, under which a party shall serve a "Disclosure of Asserted Claims and Infringement Contentions" **not later than 14 days after the initial pretrial conference.**
