ORDER


RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of a joint letter from Plaintiff Joao Control & Monitoring Systems, LLC (“JCMS”) and Defendant American Traffic Solutions, Inc. (“ATS”), dated September 30, 2014, detailing discovery disputes between the parties. (Doc. No. 128.) Having reviewed the letter, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Plaintiff’s request to continue its Rule 30(b)(6) deposition is DENIED as moot in light of defense counsel’s representation that ATS has agreed to continue the Rule 30(b)(6) deposition as necessary. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Plaintiff’s request for additional hours, costs, and an order directing ATS to produce “**all of the documents** requested by JCMS and simultaneously provide proof of reasonable search efforts, as well as costs for its efforts” (*see id.* at 3 (emphasis in original)) is also DENIED. However, in light of the obvious acrimony and distrust between the parties and their counsel, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT Ms. Jeffries, Mr. Park, and representatives of their respective clients shall appear on October 10, 2014 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 905 of the Thurgood Marshall United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, 40 Foley Square, New York, New York.

The Court will reserve a conference room in which the parties and counsel shall meet and confer with respect to discovery issues for no less than four hours.
