RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of (1) a letter from Plaintiff, dated April 3, 2014, requesting a conference regarding Plaintiff's anticipated motion for enforcement of the protective order. (Doc. No. 76); and (2) a letter from the Manwin Defendants, dated April 8, 2014, in response (Doc. No. 80). Pursuant to Rule 2.A of the Court's Individual Rules of Practice, pre-motion letters must "include citations to relevant authority and should provide a brief overview of the anticipated motion." Plaintiff's letter, however, does not explain what alleged violation of the protective order Plaintiff now seeks enforcement against. As a result, the Court has no basis to determine whether allowing Plaintiff to make its motion would advance or hinder the interests of

justice and judicial economy. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Plaintiff's request for a conference is DENIED, without prejudice to renewal with a more helpful pre-motion letter.
