RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of the parties' Joint Motion for Order of Dismissal Without Prejudice Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(2), and [Proposed] Order of Dismissal Without Prejudice Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(2), both dated May 28, 2014. The Court recognizes that, when judicial records are sealed, the closure should be "narrowly tailored." *Lugosch v. Pyramid Co. of Onodaga*, 435 F.3d 110, 120 (2d Cir. 2006). Here, Defendant has proposed narrow redactions to the Order of Dismissal, removing only confidential business information from the document. Plaintiff does not object.

Accordingly, the Court will publicly docket a redacted version of the Order of Dismissal and file an unredacted version under seal.
